

Visual Contrast Sensitivity (VCS) Tests are available online at <https://www.survivingmold.com/>.

This online screening test measures visual contrast sensitivity, one of the neurologic functions of vision that is often affected by chronic inflammation from the immune system. *(NOTE: This screening test helps to monitor your progress, but is not sufficient for making a diagnosis.)*

- Click on "Online VCS Screening Test" (Visual Contrast)
- Corrected visual acuity must be better than 20:50 in each eye (wear glasses if needed).
- Lighting must be adequate. (Light from both the illuminated computer screen and an overhead light is usually sufficient.)
- Make sure the distance from the screen to the eye stays constant at 18".
- Do the test with each eye separately, first with the left eye, and then with the right eye.
- Score is "Pass/Fail," though how well you do can show your improvement over time or worsening with re-exposure/repeat illness.
- You can purchase multiple VCS APTitude Tests to track your results over time.
