

## **Visual Contrast Sensitivity (VCS) Tests** are available online:

This online screening test measures visual contrast sensitivity, one of the neurologic functions of vision that is often affected by chronic inflammation from the immune system. *(NOTE: This screening test helps to monitor your progress, and may contribute to making a diagnosis.)*

- Corrected visual acuity must be at least 20:50 in each eye (wear glasses if needed).
- Lighting must be adequate. (Light from both the illuminated computer screen and an overhead light is usually sufficient.)
- Make sure the distance from the screen to the eye stays constant at 18".
- Do the test with each eye separately, first with the left eye, and then with the right eye.
- You can purchase multiple VCS Tests to track your results over time, and keep a journal timeline of your VCS results along with changing symptoms & treatments.
- Request emailed report to Dr Bradford. (You can also download a PDF report for your records.)
